CODE OF ETHICS FOR THE NURSING STUDENTS OF FAHS

DEAR NURSING STUDENTS,

In Nursing practice, you have a relationship with Your,

- 1. Clients (Patients)
- 2. Other Nurses
- 3. Other health Care Providers
- 4. With your Lecturers, Heads of Departments and Institution

Student Nurses are responsible for their actions that cause harm to any of the above as much as the others are:

As a direct result of your actions many others such as your,

- 1. Instructor
- 2. Nurses working with you
- 3. The Hospital or Health Care Facility and,
- 4. Faculty Members may be held <u>liable</u>

An understanding coupled with sound **judgment** will help to ensure safe and appropriate Nursing Care.

You <u>must</u> understand the limits and standards and adhere to the protocols and policies of the facility that you practice or study in.

As a Nurse it is your responsibility to Protect Clients and others from harm.

As you undertake to learn and practice in different Health Care Facilities, it will help you to keep in mind the following,

- 1. Be punctual
- 2. Be in uniform
- 3. Keep hair above collar line
- 4. Wear minimum jewelry
- 5. Follow rules and regulations and be polite and courteous at all times
- 6. Keep finger nails short, and do not wear nail polish
- 7. Adhere to the rules and regulations of the health care facility that you work in, consider the institute as your own
- 8. Do not perform a procedure that you are not familiar with
- 9. Any procedure you perform, should be under the supervision of appointed Personnel
- 10. Issues of disclosure, privacy and confidentiality, are important
- 11. Be aware of changes in rules and regulations related to client care and others
- 12. Note that controlled substances are given only under the direction of the physician and administered by the licensed physician or licensed nurse
- 13. Keep finger nails short and do not wear nail polish
- 14. Your studies are as important as all other points stated in this document, DO NOT SETTLE FOR LESS, OR BORDERLINE PASSES, REACH HIGH.
