Medals and awards details- Department of Physiotherapy

The Department of Physiotherapy annually presents a prize and a gold medal to students who demonstrate outstanding academic achievements during the B.Sc. (Hons) in Physiotherapy degree program. These recognitions are awarded based on the highest Grade Point Average (GPA) obtained for clinical courses for the prize and based on overall coursework for the gold medal.

- Alumni Association of the Department of Physiotherapy Prize for Excellence in Clinical Practice in Physiotherapy
- Alumni Association of the Department of Physiotherapy Gold Medal for Academic Excellence in Physiotherapy

Eligibility Criteria

For the Prize for Excellence in Clinical Practice:

- Highest cumulative GPA for all the clinical courses
- Obtained a minimum of B+ grade or its equivalent obtained at the first available attempt for all clinical courses
- Passed all the subjects at the first available attempt in the all examinations conducted by FAHS
- Obtained a minimum of a Second Class (Upper Division) pass or its equivalent Cumulative or Final GPA.

In the event of a tie, the FAHS shall select the most suitable candidate based on his/her performance at all the examinations and/ or any other criteria as determined by FAHS

For the Gold Medal for Academic Excellence:

- Highest cumulative GPA for all the courses
- Obtained a minimum of B grade or its equivalent obtained at the first available attempt for all clinical subjects
- Passed all the subjects at the first available attempt in all examinations (except non-credit subjects) conducted by FAHS
- Obtained a minimum of a Second Class (Upper Division) pass or its equivalent Cumulative or Final GPA.

In the event of a tie, the FAHS shall select the most suitable candidate based on highest number of A and A+ grades obtained at all the examinations conducted by FAHS. If the tie continues, the award shall be shared.

The final selection of the award and prize recipients is confirmed by the Senate based on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences (FAHS).
