

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD OF MEDALS

BOC Gold Medal

The award shall be given annually to the student who has;

1. Recorded the best performance at the **Degree Programmes** in Faculty of **Allied Health Sciences** based on the **highest GPA** and
2. Obtained a minimum of **B** or its equivalent at the first available attempt for all the subjects excluding non-credit subjects.
3. Obtained a minimum of a **Second Class (Upper Division)** or its equivalent Final GPA.
4. In the event of a tie, the Faculty of **Allied Health Sciences** shall select the most suitable candidate based on the **highest number of A+ grades and in a further tie the process to continue with highest number of A grades and then with highest number of A-grades and then with highest number of B+ grades** of his/her performance at all the examinations conducted by the Faculty of **Allied Health Sciences**.
5. The final selection of the recipient of the award shall be confirmed by the Senate based on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Allied Health Science.
6. No award shall be given to any student against whom disciplinary or legal action is pending or to any student who has been subject to punishment by the University or a Court of Law while being registered as a student of the University.
