REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD OF MEDALS

A) Professor P.B. Hewavithana Gold Medal for Academic Excellence in Radiography

The award shall be given annually to the students who have;

- 1. Passed all the subjects in the relevant examinations conducted by the Faculty and has obtained a minimum of a Second Class (Upper Division) pass or its equivalent Final GPA.
- 2. Recorded the Highest GPA of not less than 3.50 in the Bachelor of Science Honours in Radiography Degree
- 3. In the event of a tie, the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences shall select the most suitable candidate based on the total number of A+ grades at all Levels.
- 4. In the case where there is a further tie, the most suitable candidate will be selected based on the total number of A+ and A grades for the courses offered at all levels.
- 5. The final selection of the recipient of the award shall be confirmed by the Senate based on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Allied Health Science.

B) Professor P.B. Hewavithana Gold Medal for Academic Excellence in Radiotherapy

- 1. Passed all the subjects in the relevant examinations conducted by the Faculty and has obtained a minimum of a Second Class (Upper Division) pass or its equivalent Final GPA.
- 2. The award shall be given annually to the students who have recorded the Highest GPA of not less than 3.50 in the Bachelor of Science Honours in Radiotherapy Degree Program
- 3. In the event of a tie, the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences shall select the most suitable candidate based on the total number of A+ grades at all Levels.
- 4. In the case where there is a further tie, the most suitable candidate will be selected based on the total number of A+ and A grades for the courses offered at all levels.
- 5. The final selection of the recipient of the award shall be confirmed by the Senate based on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Allied Health Science.
